

RESOLUTION 2024-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA (“CITY”) ADOPTING A MORATORIUM FOR 60 DAYS ON ACCEPTING OR PROCESSING APPLICATIONS SEEKING THE ISSUANCE OF A SIGN PERMIT FOR FREE STANDING SIGNS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a legal challenge has been made regarding the legality of certain provisions of the Sign Ordinance for the City of Smyrna, at Chapter 82 of the Smyrna Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concludes that it is necessary and desirable to adopt a moratorium for 60 days on accepting or processing applications seeking the issuance of a sign permit for free standing signs while a legal review of the Sign Ordinance is conducted.

THEREFORE, IT IS NOW RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SMYRNA, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:

1. A moratorium is hereby issued prohibiting the City from accepting or processing applications seeking the issuance of a sign permit for free standing signs. The moratorium will extend for 60 days beginning July 15, 2024, during which time the city will conduct a legal review of the City’s Sign Ordinance.
2. This resolution imposes a temporary moratorium and not a final legislative action.
3. **Severability**. To the extent any portion of this Resolution is declared to be invalid, unenforceable, or nonbinding, that shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution.
4. **Repeal of Conflicting Provisions**. All City resolutions are hereby repealed to the extent they are inconsistent with the Resolution.
5. **Effective Date**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

This Resolution was adopted by the Governing Authority of the City of Smyrna, Georgia on the 15th day of July, 2024.
