Mayor Pro Tem / Chairperson Tim Gould called to order the December 19, 2023 Committee to Honor Fanny Williams meeting at 5:03 PM.

4. Formal Business

A. 2023-243 Approval of Final Design

Mayor Pro Tem / Chairperson Tim Gould welcomed everyone and thanked them for their assistance with this project.

Ashley Youmans, Special Projects Manager, presented artist David Wilson's updated/revised designs: one from December 3 with revisions from the last meeting and another on December 14 providing a model with a shorter hemline and three options for head wraps. The committee reviewed and discussed each element.

- Stance
- Face/Smile
- Hemline
- Head Wrap

The committee agreed with the revisions to the original design. When discussing the head wrap options, committee members mentioned that option #1, the non-textured head wrap from the December 14th presentation, was preferred. It is a cleaner look and represents more closely what Fanny Williams has often been pictured wearing.

Ms. Youmans explained that, assuming this design is approved today, the artist will move ahead with the fabricator and engineer to determine final spec plans. Mr. Wilson will be working with the Smyrna Community Development Department for permitting. Staff is continuing to prepare the site. Mr. Wilson is still anticipating delivering the statue in late February. Jerienne Bonner-Grimes asked if there is going to be a celebratory unveiling of the statue. Chairperson Gould said there will definitely be an event to unveil this project.

Ms. Bonner-Grimes expressed her gratitude for staff and Smyrna leadership for taking this project and seeing it through, especially as it began as something somewhat distressful. This is something to be proud of, and she thanked everyone involved.

Committee Member Jerienne Bonner-Grimes made a motion to approve item 2023-243, the final design for the Fanny Williams Legacy Project; seconded by Committee Member Lewis Wheaton.
