On Sunday, April 21, setup may begin at 7:00 am and include the Market Village from S. Atlanta Road toward City Hall. At least one cross way must remain open at all times to allow traffic to move between both parking area sides of the Market Village. The traffic circle will be open both Saturday and Sunday night ASAP after the last band has finished with all streets to open concluding event close and cleanup on Sunday, April 21.
