ISSUE AND BACKGROUND:

The FY24 budget approved by Council included revenue projections based on 8.99 mills. This is the last of three required public hearings before the formal adoption of the 8.99 millage rate. Tax information was received from Cobb County on June 29, 2023. Per the information provided, the City would need to roll back the millage rate to 7.829 to not advertise a tax increase. In comparison, last year's millage rollback was calculated at 8.048.

The official notice, and all required information, was posted in the Marietta Daily Journal on July 20, 2023 and July 27, 2023. A press release was sent to the Marietta Daily Journal on July 18, 2023. It has also been posted on the City website. This is the last required public hearing. Additional hearings were held on July 27, 2023, at 10AM and August 3, 2023 at 10:00 am.

This is the formal adoption of the millage rate.
