ISSUE AND BACKGROUND:

The Smyrna ARTery concept goal is to introduce public art opportunities along Atlanta Road from Brawner Hall to the Belmont Shopping Center. The first projects to be implemented are utility box murals, both painted and vinyl wrapped. The Vinyl Wrapped Utility Box project includes utility boxes located at two intersections along Atlanta Road: Powder Springs Street and Church Street (near the Publix Jonquil sign).

The city received 32 submissions for RFQ 23-029 Call to Artists: Vinyl Wrapped Utility Boxes. Members of the Arts & Culture Task Force scored the submissions and recommended two artists, one for each available utility box in this project. The task force recommends awarding the project to artists Becca McCoy and Wendy Meyer. Artists will each receive a \$500 stipend for execution of their work.
