The City of Smyrna appreciates the opportunity to apply for funding through the FY 2023 LMIG Safety Action Plan. The city has undertaken several projects in recent years with a focus on traffic calming to mitigate excessive speeding. The SAP is consistent with these goals in the city, and we would like to apply for the program grant.

Please find attached the City of Smyrna's LMIG application. Our project list includes edge striping for Reed Road, signage, and pavement markings to better identify the intersection of Village Parkway and Lake Park Drive, and RPMs and RRFB's at several locations on Concord Road, as well as replacing guardrail that does not conform with current GDOT standards on Cooper Lake Road at the East-West Connector and is a potential hazard.

Regarding the status of our previous LMIG funding, our most recent application, LMIG-2023-15963, was approved on December 20, 2022. For this application, our source for the required matching funds is the 2022 Cobb County SPLOST program, under which we have a specific allocation for Traffic Calming.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AFFIDAVIT AND CERTIFICATION


