**ISSUE AND BACKGROUND:**

The existing 24" CMP storm line in the rear yard of 6015 Bordeaux Walk is part of the City's infrastructure and its condition warrants rehabilitation. The construction activity to replace the pipe conventionally would be cost prohibitive and the construction impact significant to several homes. Cleaning and installing a cured-in-place line will restore the capacity of the pipe to convey offsite stormwater flows from the trailer park in the County adjacent to this home and mitigate overflow runoff volumes.

Staff recommends approval to award to Utility Asset Management, Inc., 1902 Tucker Ind. Rd., Tucker, GA 30084, in the amount of \$150,246.00 to be funded from Stormwater CIP for the cleaning and cured-in-place lining of the existing 24" CMP located between 6015 Bordeaux Walk and Vineyard Way.
